

Front adhesive material datasheet

Overview

A clear material with the adhesive over the printed layer so it can be stuck to the inside of glass or clear plastic materials.

A laminate protects the printed layer on the back, giving it excellent durability. It has a medium-strength adhesive, suitable for a wide range of applications. Designed to be used up to 3 years.

Material construction

The image below shows a cross-section of the material, along with details of each part of the material:



- O 125 GSM backing paper
- O Permanent, acrylic pressure-sensitive adhesive
- O Clear gloss, 70 micron calendered PVC vinyl
- O 12-15 microns of ink + 12-15 microns of white ink
- O Clear gloss, 70 micron calendered PVC overlaminate
